Frequently Asked Questions

Q: *What do I need to bring?*

A: Yourself, an open heart and an open mind. If you have a Bible, bring it; if you don't have a Bible, we will provide one for you.

Q: *What if I have never studied or even read the Bible before?*

A: We offer both Faith Foundational studies and Faith Building studies to meet you where you are in your bible knowledge. We have trained leaders who are here to help you.

Q: *What if I don't know anyone?*

A: Don't worry! This will be a wonderful opportunity to meet women of all ages and backgrounds, drawn together by a common desire to learn what the Bible teaches and how it that relates to our lives.

Q: *What if I'm not sure what I believe?*

A: You're not alone! Women come to Heart to Heart Bible study to search for answers together. All questions are welcome.

Q: *How is a Bible study different from going to church?*

A: Instead of passively listening, Bible study is interactive. You will hear many viewpoints, add your own, and verify what you learn directly from the Bible.

Q: *What's the goal of the Bible study?*

A: To become more familiar with using the Bible as a foundational resource. We focus on how the Scriptures relate to our lives. Bible study skills are also learned.

Q: *What are the homework requirements?*

A: The average time spent reading and preparing for the study is 45 minutes.

Q: *I have a child getting off the kindergarten bus (or a job), and would need to leave early or may arrive late; will that be a problem?*

A: This is a women's Bible study, we support the needs and schedules of working women and moms. Come as often as you can and stay as long as you can so that Bible study fits into your schedule. We offer Tuesday morning and Tuesday evening studies to accommodate the varying schedules of women.

Q: *I don't attend Pepperell Christian Fellowship; will there be women there who attend other churches or who don't attend church?*

A: We welcome ALL women whether they attend church or not. There are approximately fifteen different churches and towns represented through the women who attend the Heart to Heart Community Bible study.
